Tues 3. Bill went to Grosvenor Hospital for Women.

Ivor Back was 1 1/2 hrs. late for his appointment, & then made an outrageous scene.

Thur 5. Credit: 12.0 1/8 1/2d 1.0 #100.1.8 1/d 9.0 #25 odd

Such are the vicissitudes of modern life!

Moved to Park Lane Hotel

Fri 6. Complete salvage operations as far as humanly possible. Lunch with Deborah. She came to Grosvenor Hosp. after, & was all honey.

Sat 7. Got Bill off to Brighton. Discovered libel at 23 Praed St. Placard that my first novel had been banned.

Bill rang up late--Norah is playing the bitch. Bill wants to come back. She rang up that sex-crazy old dope-addict & spilt the beans! Then the fat old brothel-keeper rang me up after 12, & started slanders against Bill--the foulest insults. I cut off: so she went on raving at the telephone clerk!

Sun 8. General Hogg--I presume in ignorance of the fact that I had told the operator that I should complain to the police if his wife continued to pester me.

Bill back--horns of hell.

do dogs; do flapperette.

Sat 28. Report of Week I of Purification. Asthma better, but
not much so. Nerves. Very much better. Sleep. Still very
broken. Stricture. Quite miraculously less. Digestion. Stom-
ach distended in spite of Ureclidin.

Turker--not amusing. Weight 13 st. 6---188 lb.

Returned Officially to London by dining at the Berkeley Grill.

Sun 29. Slept fairly well. For the first time in very many
months I had the "cat-feeling"--direct pleasure in the body as
such. This after bath.

Met Marie of Bulgaria after all these. 35 Grover St. Room 2
Mus. 8598.

Mon 30. II.

Tues 31. 1.30. Ch. Evans to lunch here. That rotten Galsworthy
croaked, & it was off!

FEBRUARY

Wed 1. Engineer Piccadilly 11.30.

Fri 3. Down to [yod d]. The short-sighted stupidity of these
"backers" is the limit.

Sat 4. Charles Spencer 113 Cheyne Walk Flax 8727 a pretentious ass.

Tues 7. Hilda 4 Park Lane Flat F May 0339 Probable.

Opus 1 as usual, n.g. after all these months. Elixir hardly to be had--Juventutem.

Slept 1 1/2 hrs. but still bad. Electric storm & rain did this.

Sat 11. Can't sleep for Ideas. Consultations start: go round Grill etc. at lunch, "looking for something" e.g. the pleasant cute smile (?), the best anus, the wittiest word, etc. I give present to one I choose.

Opus 3 M. Splendid, though I'm not yet really myself; & she is so deeply set & inaccessible.

Sun 12. Terrible cramps all night prevented sleep. Took whole day off in bed. Asthma not too good, either.

Mon 13. IV.

11.0 Cochran. 6.45 Park lane Dongall.

Opus 4. 1 1/2 hrs. but see(?).

She is the most marvellous fuckstress alive.

Tues 14. Cheque for Watson.

Opus 5 both of us coughing badly. Elx. more accessible, better formed, more of it. V. concentrated on will.

Wed 15. Coughing quite bad. Woke 3.40 about with really bad cramp in right calf. Had to have tea made.

3.0 Toogood's man at Hotel. (Like all English, utterly blank dullness; doesn't care whether he sells anything or not. Shows appallingly bad stuff).

Fri 17. [peh] 6 Marianne.

Sat 18. Pretty sick.

Sun 19. Ill in bed all day. Cough frightful.

Mon 20. V.

Mg. Phosp. 3X. Cough better.

Opus 7 Marianne. At last it works fairly well. Amrita well-formed, ample, good quality.

Wed 22. Opus 8 Marianne. Getting really in form. But El. elusive.

Thur 23. Coeur-de-Lion turned to Queue-de-Lion. Ugh!

Cochran made magnificently good #15 cash, & #35 to fill loan on Tuesday next.

Opus 9 Marianne. Tired--so short, normal, A.1. Lots of El.-special intention for Lowenhaupt.

Fri 24. Opus 10 a la paresseuse. Concentrated well on (?) E.L. Plenty of Elixir well-made--made on floor to earth it.

Sat 25. Saw E.L. at v. genial. Together to Huntsman.

Opus 11 Au. El. on pince-nez bridge. This worked too.

Sun 26. 5. Ham.

Opus 12 against asthma-bronchitis etc. specially: for health & strength in general.

On Monday asthma was cured suddenly--not merely bettered.

Mon 27. VI.

Report of 5 weeks.

Sex-life v. actively restored--day after 2nd dose Amrita. Stricture wholly gone. Asthma much changed in character-- distinctly better, but persists. Thoughts all robust & juvenile e.g. I think naturally of ski if it snows; I want to walk rather than ride etc., etc. Irritated (7 a.m.) because I can't go & take exercise!

Everything went wrong all day.

Opus 13. Health esp. bronch. Very tired. This immortal masterpiece was a triumph of enthusiasm, intelligence, patience, & technique.

Tues 28. Even God rested on the Seventh day--I make no further apology.

MARCH

Wed 1. Cheque for Gaston, do Dollard: postponed.

Bill really insane, making public scandals in Mayfair Wine Bar & at Pamela's. Threats of blackmail & murder, not only to me, but to Hamilton, whom she pesters continually by 'phone.

Opus 14 [Gk SHN?] etc., appeal etc.

Thur 2. Donegall & Philips to lunch arranged (at last!) to try out 93 game.

Sudden warm weather--utterly washed out. Am now sleeping perfectly.

Fri 3. Mrs. Barr South Hall Berkhamstead Herts.

Mr. Richards 'phones with invitation. Jayne was glad to hear from me. Hammond called at 10.30 P.M. quite out of the blue.

E.L. wrote re. Mrs. Barr.

? results of March 1.

Opus 15 n.v.g. etc. V. tired still.

Sat 4. Wrote Mrs. Barr etc.

Opus 16 I.M.D. This was the fault of clumsiness & the bed--which makes one slip.

Sun 5. Took Bill to Richmond for her birthday party--instead of to-morrow. Met George Slocombe & family in R. Park. What a bourgeois he has become!

Walk 7 or 8 miles in all--dead tired & aching all over-- slept 4.40-6.20--aching all over--. Collapsed a bit--asthma back. Wild dreams of adultery & mountains. Disturbed night.

Mon 6. VII.

Tried out 93 game with Philips & Wynn-Williams in garage. An oily proposition! Anita Goss turned up! 'phoned at the lunch hour!

Opus 7 to be irresistible in [sigma].

Tues 7. Marianne leaves for Buda pesth. Paris 3 rue du Mont-Thabor (till Thursday). BudaP. Horthy Miklos 36.

Jayne 1.0 to lunch.

Mrs. Richards tea--to meet Lady Dunn.

Juanita 6.30--I'm in it.

Wed 8. Juanita Gross. Flax 8963 11d Hogarth Road before 9.30 A.M.

Kerman 12. Juanita 1 o'c.

Thur 9. 1.0 Juanita.

Fri 10. 3.0 Milton Elwy Jones 93. A.1. try out of 93.

Saw Allan's garage for 93.

Sat 11. Hear that Slippery Joe has been caught double-crossing the Chinks. I assume that they will ... him & ... him & ferret him, & discourse the ... in Chinese unto him. Bill upset!

4.30 Maud Allan. Lord! what a thrill.

Millie Sharp 1 Oxf. Gerrard 1441.

Sun 12. Milton & Bill to lunch over 93.

Millie--Ugh!

Mon 13. VIII.

1.0 Cheshire Cheese Slocombe.

Thur 16. Wisked (?) Bill on to Rex Smythe The Rectory Bares (14) Suffolk.

Eleanor de Sylva 20 Halla St...Ugh!
Brilliant game v. athenaeum. Rook sacrifice.

Fri 17. Fooled with Eleanor de S.

To Hastings--hotels jammed, after great efforts found the Cromwell--opp. St. L. pier. Clean & cheap & not bad.

Sun 19. Damned ill with asthma--very sudden attack. No brekker --the gale--& a big Whisky on an empty stomach, I suppose.
Chess.

Mon 20. More chess. Back to London, thank God! No news. Looked for [circle].

Tues 21. IX.

da Sylva--of the Wood!

12.30 P.M. See Memo for '34 e.v. 1.43 A.M. [chart: I never saw a more forbidding figure!]

Thurs 23. For a week or more have been getting into Apophis-stage in health--all old troubles coming out very severely.

Fri 24. Arranging Bill's marriage.

Opus Ivy [X?]. The best for a long while--all spontaneous & easy at once. All Quality! [Gk S??]-appeal--Health etc.

Wed 29. Lunch with Lion's-tail at R.A.C. (?) Fine lunch--but only evasions & cowardice.

Thur 30. Wrote E.L. a very temperate but firm letter.

Locked out!

Fri 31. Lewenzwange furious at my letter! Guilty conscience! Arranging Biff stunt with Miss Gudgeon, Miss Day, & Capt. Philips. April Day told me O'Conner had "White Stains" in his safe.

APRIL

Sat 1. Playing BIFF against the wall of the Old Bailey.

Sun 2. April Day S1 5305. Ill all day.

Mon 3. Consulting the crowd as to new stunt.

Wed 5. Mary Endgevu's (?) Cheques R/D. Went to lawyers etc. & finally to Vine St.

[In April or May 1933 Nancy Cunard organised an appeal for the Scottsboro Boys. Crowley signed her appeal as follows:
Aleister Crowley. Scientific Essayist.

This case is typical of the hysterical sadism of the American people--the result of Puritanism and the climate.

Nancy Cunard copied the above for me from the original in her keeping in Dec. 1954. G.J. Yorke]

Thur 6. Vine St. 11.30. They are kind to criminals! In France the three would have been questioned, caught out, & been made to give each other away. All in a day!

Moved out a few necessaries.

Fri 7. The doomed Bastion fell at last.

Moved to Astoria Hl. where Nancy Cunard is staying. Met her again.

Sat 8. Police re. Bill & Geo. Keene.

Sun 9. Drinking with Mannalor(?). Anti-War meeting in Traf. Sq. against the Scottsborough Outrage turned to African Rally 8 P.M. It would have been a perfect party if the lads had brought their razors! I danced with many whores--all colours.

Fri 14. Called on Very Maxwell. N.G. No brains.

Opus May Lewis. A.1. Success.

Mon 17. XII.

Ring da Sylva.

Tues 18. Cochran 10.15 Rink King. Wynn Williams.

Thank God these hellish holidays are over [Bank holiday].

Saw "I am a fugitive from a chain-gang." I would be one myself if I could get away.

Wed 19. Ring Goulden--Referee. Lewenhaupt.

Retired in good order from Soho, bands playing, colours flying, without the loss of a man or a gun.

To Hammon (?). Bill to Albatross (?). Lewen at R.A.L. (?)

Thur 20. Ring da S. Mrs. Wood. Nash's N.G. Preston of Referee knew me from 1914. (V.B.N. in Adelphi.)

Fri 21. Paid Mrs. W. 4 1/s gs. Bill more ungrateful, insulting, threatening & impossible than ever.

Sat 22. Entered 17 New Cavendish St. Langham 2510. Mrs. W. extremely kind & thoughtful. And practical! She seems to me to be the other half of my mind--that I have lacked so long.

Sun 23. Karl Germer Pfalzburgerstr 9 Berlin W 15.

[peh] May Lewis. Success. This in [?].

Monday 24. XIII.

Ian Coster "Despatch." Lunch with Preston.

Tues 25. Coster postpones contract.

Wed 26. Miss E. Smith 40 Pell St Kensington W8 very kind in looking after me. See May 1-8.

Mon 1. Lunch with Rayner at Monico. Poisoned by mushrooms.

Sat 16. Threw out Ian Russell.

Opus 16. Health. (19th May nose perfectly clear as in spring after similar Opn.)

Sun 17. Dinner at Garnets (?).

Opus 17. Success in this week's work. This is the most terrific operation that I remember.

Mon 18. Opus 18 [peh] # O'D.

Tues 19. Opus 19 >17! Perfect ease & control. To consecrate the S.'.W.'.

Wed 20. Opus 20. To put power in Her hand.

Thur 21. Threw out Commander Falls.

Fri 22. Threw out Michael Corssman--but he sneaked back, caught Pearl alone, & got her to let him stay.

Saturday [23]. 1.0 a.m. Opus 21 [peh] to get the Word.

KAANI--accompanied by a vision of Adept in Himalayas.

Sat 23. [horary figure of Equinox]

11.0 a.m. Michael formally invested with the Order of the B... 's [Bum's] Rush, Departs to undertake his new duties.

5.0 Mrs. Driver arrived--a most charming & distinguished lady. P. announced our engagement.

Sun 24. 1.30 a.m. Opus 22. Love--the oath.
Pan came & left a smell of goat in the room.

Wed 4. Jayne 11.15 Martinez.

Opus 34. I.M.D. at end???

Thur 5. Resting up a bit.

Fri 6. Opus 32. The Sacrament of Love (Whew!).

[Saturnus] arrived.

Utterly aching & exhausted--both of us.

Sat 7. Sorted books & pictures. To bed early 7 to work.

Sun 8. Opus 33. [resh] after hours (?)--Uniting by opus to [vav].

Opus 34 on waking. Lust & power of Lust.

Mon 9. Opus 35. I.M.D. [in manu dominae] to end. Success. All these are very intense & we are both really F.O.

Tues 10. Settled Kerman costs [by depositing MSS diaries etc. which I bought from him some ? years earlier for #100].

Arrival of an old friend of S.W. Jack Toyne, upsets her badly. Spent most of night in arguments & visions.

Wed 11. Opus 36. Hymen. All night talk & love.

Thur 12. Jack back--guess he knows about it all--he knows--he knows.

A very happy birthday.

Fri 13. Jack blew out at midnight.

Sat 14. Opus 37. Success--in re. v. Const[able].

Sun 15. Opus 38 [peh]. Success etc. ?

Mon 16. Jayne 6 o'clock. 87 Victoria St.

Opus 39. Health. Sudden & spontaneous before lunch.

([Saturnus] overheard all: furious!)

O'D. to dinner. Kerman later.

Opus crazily without a break till 5.30 A.M.

Pearl & I both sick -----Wed 18-----

Thur 19. Opus 40. Health. Both feel instantly better. P.S. This lasted & her [Luna] came on at last.

Fri 20. Opus 41 [peh] ?

Things from park lane.

Sat 21. S.W. divining. What will be the issue of Crowley v. Constable et al.? (1 stick slipped). XXIX Khwan [moon of moon]. S.W. definitely [moon]. ?[hexagram] right.

Began Opus about 11.

Sun 22. Opus 42. I.M.D. to end. Red Gold. An all-night job, terrific for pain.

Frank Lewis to dinner; he solves all Nina [Hamnett] & Betty [May] mysteries.

Mon 23. Opus 43. Aur. Rub.
